TOEIC Listening Test - Preparation

TOEIC is a proficiency test that assesses a wide range of language, therefore, test takers should concentrate on improving their overall language skills.

However, being familiar with the test format, directions and types of questions allow test takers to focus more on demonstrating their language proficiency.

TOEIC Listening Test - Preparation

- ☐ In the Listening test, you will be asked to demonstrate how well you understand spoken English.
- The entire Listening test will last approximately 45 minutes.
- There are four parts, and directions are given for each part.
- You must mark your answers on the separate answer sheet. Do not write your answers in your test book.

Listening, Part 1 (Photographs)

Listening (part 1, Photographs) Direction

For each question in this part, you will hear four statements about a picture in your test book. When you hear the statements, you must select the one statement that best describes what you see in the picture. Then find the number of the question on your answer sheet and mark your answer. The statements will not be printed in your test book and will be spoken only one time.

Listening (part 1) Test Tips

1. Preview the picture

- Make predictions
- Focus on the most important people or things in the picture.

2. Avoid common distractors

- o Similar sound
- Wrong information
- Minor details

Listening, Part 2 (Question - Response)

Listening (part 2, Question - Response) Direction

You will hear a question or statement and three responses spoken in English. They will not be printed in your test book and will be spoken only one time. Select the best response to the question or statement and mark the letter (A), (B), or (C) on your answer sheet.

Listening (part 2, Question - Response) Example

On the recording, you will hear:

Where is the meeting room?

You will also hear:

- (A) To meet the new director.
- (B) It's the first room on the right.
- (C) Yes, at two o'clock.

Listening (part 2, Question - Response) Test Tips

- 1. Focus on question word
 - Who / when / where / etc.
- 2. Indirect answer
 - Focus on meaning
- 3. Avoid distractors
 - Same word distractors
 - Related word distractors

Listening, Part 3 (Conversations)

Listening (part 3, Conversations) Direction

You will hear some **conversations** between two or more people. You will be asked to answer **three questions** about what the speakers say in each conversation. Select the best response to each question and mark the letter (A), (B), (C), or (D) on your answer sheet. **The conversations will not be printed in your test book and will be spoken only one time.**

Listening (part 3, Conversations)

Example

On the recording, you will hear:

(Woman) Hello. I'm calling about a coffee machine I purchased from your Web site. It stopped working even though I haven't had it for very long. I expected it to last much longer than this.

(Man) Oh, I'm sorry to hear that. Our warranty covers products for up to a year. Do you know when you bought it?

(Woman) I've had it for a little over a year, so the warranty has probably just expired. This is so disappointing.

(Man) Well, I'll tell you what we can do. Although we can't replace it, since you're a valued customer I can offer you a coupon for forty percent off your next purchase.

Listening (part 4, Talks) Direction

You will hear some **talks** given by a single speaker. You will be asked to answer **three questions** about what the speaker says in each talk. Select the best response to each question and mark the letter (A), (B), (C), or (D) on your answer sheet. The talks will not be printed in your test book and will be spoken only one time.

Listening (part 4, Talks) Example

On the recording you will hear:

(Man) Hello Mr. Lee, this is Thomas from BKS Auto Shop calling with some information about your car repair. I know we told you that it would take until next week to get the part we ordered, but we got the part early, and I was able to finish the repair. We're going to be closing for the day in a few minutes, but you're welcome to come get your car anytime tomorrow. If you need a ride to the shop tomorrow, let me know, and I can arrange one for you.

Then you will hear:

- 71. What does the speaker say about the repair?
- 72. When can the listener pick up his car?
- 73. What does the speaker offer to do?
